STRATEGIC ALLIANCES

Suzuki Motor Corporation, a Japanese vehicle manufacturer, holds approximately 0.27 percent of GM shares and GM holds approximately three percent of Suzuki shares. In addition, SMC owns 14.9 percent of GM Daewoo Auto & Technology (GMDAT), a Korean vehicle manufacturer. Suzuki, GM and GMDAT will continue to optimize the use of powertrains, parts and components, and the development of the future products.

CANADIAN AUTOMOTIVE MANUFACTURING, INC. (CAMI)

CAMI is an independently incorporated joint venture between Suzuki Motor Corporation (50 percent) and General Motors of Canada Ltd., (50 percent). It is located in Ingersoll, Ontario, Canada and currently builds the Chevrolet Equinox, the Pontiac Torrent and the Suzuki XL7. Established in 1986, it started production in 1989. CAMI currently employs 2,772 employees, and has produced more than two million vehicles. In the 2005 Harbour Report, CAMI was ranked No. 3 in Truck Assembly in the Small SUV category of the 45 auto assembly plants in North America.
